How to Fold & Pack your SkyAngle CERT-3 Series Parachute

Proper preparation of your new SkyAngle CERT-3 Series Parachute helps conserve recovery compartment space and enables a positive, tangle-free deployment. Follow the steps below for maximum performance of your SkyAngle CERT-3. (See our Deployment FreeBag™ instructions for CERT-3 use with our Deployment Bag.)

Step 1

Lay out your CERT-3 parachute on ground and pull the chute taut along its axis. (The 4 suspension lines form a natural guide that segments the chute into 4 lateral sections.) Fold lengthwise in a zig-zag fashion until a 6"-8" width, or the diameter of your compartment, remains. (Large chutes will require a number of lengthwise folds.)



Step 2

Starting at the apex, fold the chute in a zig-zag fashion (in approx. 6"-8" sections, depending on compartment space) to the tip of the chute skirt.



Step 3

Fold the suspension lines in a zig-zag fashion and attach the nickel-plated swivel at the end of the suspension lines to the attachment point of your shock cord, which can also be gathered in a zig-zag manner. Position your Aramid® protector or wadding, and slide the shock cord and chute package into the recovery compartment. (Cords first, then chute.)
